Samling Flies in Medical Supplies to Fight Covid-19

Frontline health workers are integral to our response to COVID-19. Health workers are taking on significant personal risk and too often working without adequate equipment to ensure all of us can receive the care we need.

As part of our commitment to health and safety, Samling Group is flying in the much-needed medical equipment and supplies to help fight COVID-19. The first batch will be donated to hospitals in Miri, Bintulu, Sarikei, Lawas as well as other nearby hospitals and clinics.

We are also assisting the Miri Hospital to upgrade their existing molecular laboratory with a real-time Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) machine, medical-grade refrigerator, freezers, bio-safety cabinet, thermocycler, centrifuge and other personal protective equipment (PPE) needed for a fully functional PCR facility. The equipment will enable Miri Hospital to carry out PCR tests around the clock starting next week instead of having to wait between 48 to 72 hours for results from Sarawak General Hospital in Kuching.
